AN ACT RELATING TO THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, DUVAL COUNTY; AMENDING CHAPTER 92-341, LAWS OF FLORIDA, AS AMENDED; AMENDING SECTION 13.07, PROVIDE FOR ELECTION TO RATHER APPOINTMENT, OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS, TO PROVIDE FOR A TERM OF FOUR YEARS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR A TWO-TERM LIMIT; TO PROVIDE FOR HOLDOVER FOR THE CURRENT SUPERINTENDENT; PROVIDING THE AMENDMENT HEREIN SHALL TAKE EFFECT ONLY UPON REFERENDUM APPROVAL OF THIS ACT; DIRECTING THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS FOR DUVAL COUNTY TO PLACE THE REFERENDUM QUESTION THE 2020 GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT NOVEMBER 3, 2020; PROVIDING THAT THE FIRST FULL TERM OF THE SUCH SUPERINTENDENT SHALL 2022 GENERAL BEGIN WITH THEELECTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

# Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

**Section 1**. Article 13, of chapter 92-341, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

### ARTICLE 13.

## DUVAL COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD

\* \* \*

Section 13.07. - Superintendent of Schools; two term limit.

The Duval County School Board shall designate a person with experience in school management and supervision as the

superintendent of schools who shall be the chief administrative employee of the board. The superintendent of schools shall be considered an elected constitutional officer for purposes of section 8 of article II of the State Constitution. There shall be a superintendent of schools who shall be elected for a term of four years. The initial term of the elected superintendent shall begin with the 2022 General Election. No person elected and qualified for two consecutive full terms as superintendent shall be eligible for election as superintendent for the next succeeding term. The election of the superintendent shall be governed by state electoral laws for county officers.

## Section 2. Referendum.

- (a) A referendum of the qualified electors residing in Duval County, Florida is hereby called to be held on November 3, 2020, the 2020 General Election, to determine whether this act shall become effective.
- (b) The referendum shall be held and conducted in the manner prescribed by law for holding elections under a referendum provision.
- (c) All qualified electors in Duval County shall be entitled and permitted to vote in the referendum. The places and times of voting shall be those polling places and times established for voting by law. The inspectors and clerks for the referendum shall be designated by the Supervisor of Elections in accordance with applicable State law.
- (d) The Supervisor of Elections is authorized and directed, when printing the sample and voting ballots for use in the special referendum election called in Subsection 2(a) hereinabove, to print the referendum ballot title and referendum question set forth in Sections 4 and 5 hereof on said ballots at the appropriate place therefore. Immediately after said question shall be provided a space

for the voter to indicate whether his or her vote is "yes" or "no" on the question.

Section 3. Notice of Referendum. The Supervisor of Elections is directed to ensure at least thirty (30) days notice of the referendum by publishing at least twice in a daily newspaper of general circulation in Duval County, once in the fifth week and once in the third week prior to the week in which the referendum election day is to be held, in the manner provided in Section 100.342, Florida Statutes.

Section 4. Ballot Title. The Legislature hereby directs that the referendum ballot title for the referendum question be in substantially the following form:

"AMENDING CHARTER TO PROVIDE FOR AN ELECTED,
RATHER THAN AN APPOINTED, SUPERINTENDENT OF
SCHOOLS"

Section 5. Official Ballot. The Legislature hereby directs that the following referendum question, in substantially the form set forth below, be placed on the ballot at the election called for in this act:

"Currently, the Jacksonville City Charter, Chapter 92-341, as amended, provides for an appointed Duval County Superintendent of Schools. Shall Chapter 2020-\_\_\_\_\_, Laws of Florida, which amends the Jacksonville Charter to provide that the Duval County Superintendent of Schools shall no longer be appointed by the School Board but shall be elected for a term of four years, with a two-term limit, beginning with the 2022 General Election, become effective?"

Section 6. Referendum Results. The Supervisor of Elections for Duval County, Florida shall certify the results of the referendum to the Florida Department of State in accordance with law. If a majority of the votes cast in the referendum shall be for the amendment, the amendment in Section 1 shall be approved, and shall take effect as provided in this Act.

## Section 7. Initial Term.

Upon approval of the referendum called in Section 2 and upon taking effect of the charter amendment in Section 1, the initial term of the elected superintendent shall begin with the 2022 General Election. The election of the superintendent shall be governed by state statutes regarding election of county officers.

Section 8. Holdover. The superintendent in office at the time the amendment in Section 1 takes effect shall remain in office until the 2022 General Election; provided, however, that such Superintendent is subject to removal and replacement by the Duval County School Board under such terms and conditions of any contract between the superintendent and the School Board. such Any superintendent appointed by the School Board prior to the 2022 General Election shall remain in office until the 2022 General Election; provided however, that such Superintendent is subject to removal and replacement by the Duval County School Board under such terms and conditions of any contract between the superintendent and the School Board.

Section 9. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon becoming law. If the referendum scheduled herein is approved, then the terms of section 1 of this Act shall become effective immediately upon verification of the results of the referendum's election vote.
