


Frequently Asked Questions



How do I find an in-network dentist?

1. Go to **deltadentalins.com**.
2. Look for the Find a Dentist tool on the right. Enter your location (address, ZIP code or city and state).
3. Select your network (“Delta Dental PPO” or “DeltaCare USA,” depending on your plan) from the drop-down menu. For a more targeted search, you can enter the name of your dentist or dental office below.
4. Click **Search**.

Where's my dental plan ID card?

You don't need a plan ID card. Just tell your dental office you're covered by Delta Dental Insurance Company through the City of Jacksonville, and provide your name, date of birth and social security number (or enrollee ID number).

Prefer to take an ID card with you? Create an online account at **deltadentalins.com** to print your own or access an electronic ID. Or, visit Suite 150 in City Hall, where your on-site Delta Dental representative Brittany Thomas can print one for you.

How much should my dental treatment cost?

Planning dental work over \$300? Get an estimate of how much your plan will cover. Just ask your dentist to request a pre-treatment estimate from Delta Dental. Your dentist will submit treatment plan to Delta Dental, and we'll send both you and your dentist an estimate of how much your plan would cover.
