RE: Extension of P-12-14 – Emergency Mass Notification System

We are requesting a six month extension to the current contract on the Emergency Mass Notification System provided by Emergency Communications Network for the period of May 30 through November 30, 2017.

As background, the City of Jacksonville has contracted with Emergency Communications Network (ENC) since 2014, to provide emergency telephonic notifications to residents in Duval County and City of Jacksonville official phone numbers. This extension is requested in light of the State of Florida's decision to enter into a contract with Everbridge, who provides equivalent services. The State will make the Everbridge services available to counties at no charge within the next six months. It is the Emergency Preparedness Division's intent, to transition service providers from ENC to Everbridge. This extension will allow for current residents and new subscribers to re-register with the new provider. This extension will coincide with the upcoming hurricane season June 1- November 30, 2017.

This transition phase of service providers will allow for a seamless, uninterrupted level of this critical service and ensure the ability to make emergency notifications to those persons and entities registered with the service provider for the City of Jacksonville emergency notifications.

Attached is a letter from ENC for the six month contract extension. The cost of these services will not exceed \$30,000.
