HOW TO OBSERVE & PARTICIPATE IN JACKSONVILLE HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY MEETINGS DURING THE COVID-19 STATE OF EMERGENCY

During the COVID-19 State of Emergency, the City of Jacksonville is taking steps to keep local government open and accessible to the public while also protecting the health, safety and welfare of the community. The Governor of Florida issued Executive Order 20-69 allowing local city governments to hold public meetings using telephones or computers. Until it is safe to gather at City offices again, Jacksonville Housing Finance Authority meetings will be held virtually. Below you will find a step-by-step guide to observing and participating in this new meetingformat.



Step 1: Find the Meeting Notice on the City's Homepage

Jacksonville Housing Finance Authority meeting notices can be found on the City's calendar (Click on "All Events") on the main homepage at www.coj.net. Meeting notices will include the topics to be covered, the date and time of meetings, instructions for accessing the virtual meeting room via the app and phone, and instructions for making public comment if applicable. Additionally, any meeting materials that would typically be distributed at the meeting will be posted on the Jacksonville Housing Finance Authority's website prior to the meeting.



Step 2: Familiarize Yourself with the Zoom Program

Zoom is available for free at https://zoom.us/. The program will allow you to observe Jacksonville Housing Finance Authority meetings as they happen. If you sign-in using your computer, you will see video of the Jacksonville Housing Finance Authority members from their offsite locations. You can also use your phone to call-in and listen to the audio as it happens. If you are using Zoom for the first time, please give yourself time before the meeting starts to download the app or create an account.



Step 3: Provide Public Comment from Home

The meeting notice will provide information and instructions so that you can provide your comment on public issues. Please know that informational meetings may not include a public comment time but this will be clear in the meeting notice. If you do not find information regarding public comment in the meeting notice, you can reach out to the meeting contact whose information is found at the bottom of the notice. You can also call the City's helpline, 630-CITY. Comments there are shared with the proper officials and tracked along with all of the other calls on the same topic.

Please have patience. This is a time of learning for us all! We are also learning and expect there may be some mistakes as we move forward together in these challenging times. Please help us improve our process by submitting feedback and suggestions to ethics@coi.net.
