Summary of Program: The 1,000 in 1,000 program moves families out of poverty by helping them build 10 Pivotal Assets that have been statistically shown to dramatically increase the probability that families will be able to move from poverty to self-sufficiency. Each family has 1,000 days to complete their work (approximately 3 years).
