<p>Summary of Program: The JaxPAL Teen Leadership Program was developed and is designed to assist youth between the ages of 13 and 18 in developing important skills for success in college, the workforce and life. JaxPAL/JSO officers and staff assist with the program and act as mentors and chaperones to teen participants.</p> <p>The primary goal of the program is to provide teens with leadership, social, and professional skills needed for their transition to adulthood. The teens run their own meetings, work on community service projects, and participate in leadership workshops and conferences.</p> <p>Program Overall Status: We had our open house and orientation for new members on 2-13-2017. We had 19 teens join the program. This brings our total participant count to 27. 6 teens took advantage of our internship program, by working the JaxPAL winter basketball games. This opportunity provided the teens with the on the ground job skills, increased ability to manage time, stress, and communication, increased ability to receive and implement feedback, and increase their confidence. Through this program, the teens received a monthly stipend for the games they worked. We met on 2-27-2017, where the teens planned their community service project for the month of March. The event will be an outing to the humane society, where they will volunteer. Information was given out regarding the State PAL of Florida youth conference, where teen members will attend in June. Our next meeting is March 13, where the teens will focus on team building. The teens will also participate in the "Jax Youth Improvement Movement," on Saturday April 1, 2017 at City Hall. We have reached our goal of 20 teens.</p>
