Program Strategy: <i>To intervene with first time juvenile offenders of a violent crime, providing them alternative strategies to address conflict other than violence.</i>		
<p>Summary of Program: <i>Turning Point: Re-Thinking Violence (TPRV) is a six-week, court-ordered program, in accordance with the State Attorney's Office probationary criteria. Selected teens and their parents/guardians initially attend the Trauma Experience, followed by five weeks of group therapy sessions for the teens only. During the five-week group process, parents are court-ordered to also attend Week #3 and Week #6. The program incorporates a multidisciplinary format, inclusive of the Trauma Experience, the Victim Impact Panel, the Group Process, and Community Networking, thus engaging multiple community entities.</i></p> <p>Program Overall Status: <i>Our Program Coordinator has completed the SAMIS training and is prepared for program reporting. Both of our group facilitators have been working with the State Attorney's Office and the Department of Juvenile Justice to begin receiving referrals for the first track for our program. We anticipate Track #1 will begin on 7/24/17, with sessions occurring on the following dates: 7/24/17, 7/31/17, 8/7/17, 8/14/17, 8/21/17, and graduation on 8/28/17. Screenings for TPRV participants are occurring currently. The referral strategies linking TPRV with Daniel Memorial for wrap-around services post-TPRV graduation have also been completed.</i></p>
