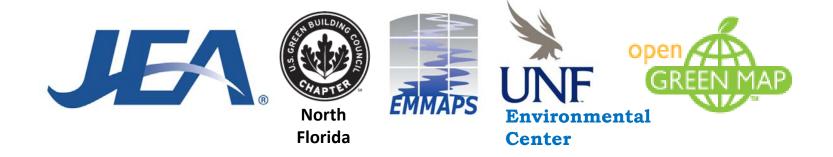
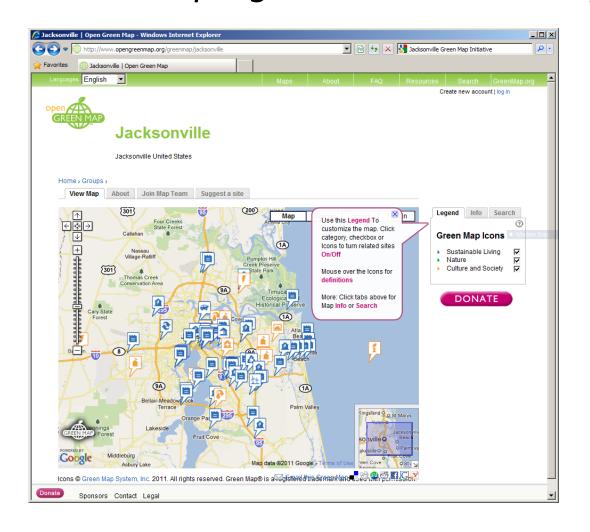
Introducing the Jacksonville "Green Map" Initiative

The Jacksonville Green Map is a map of our city that tells our good news story by highlighting what we as a community are doing to achieve environmental and human sustainability.

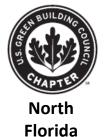
An educational resource that highlights and documents Jacksonville's progress on sustainability.

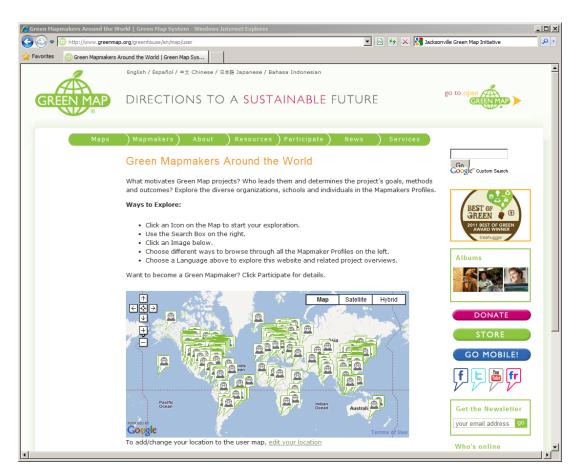

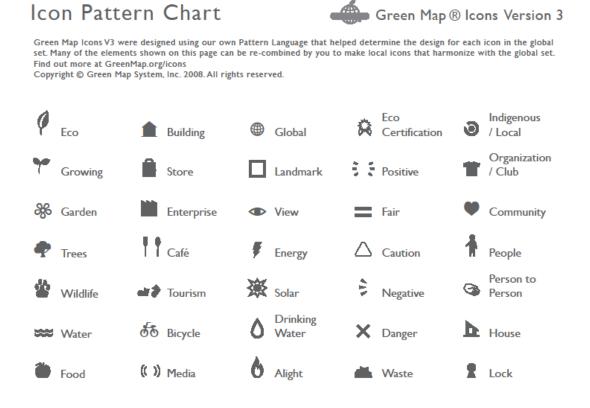


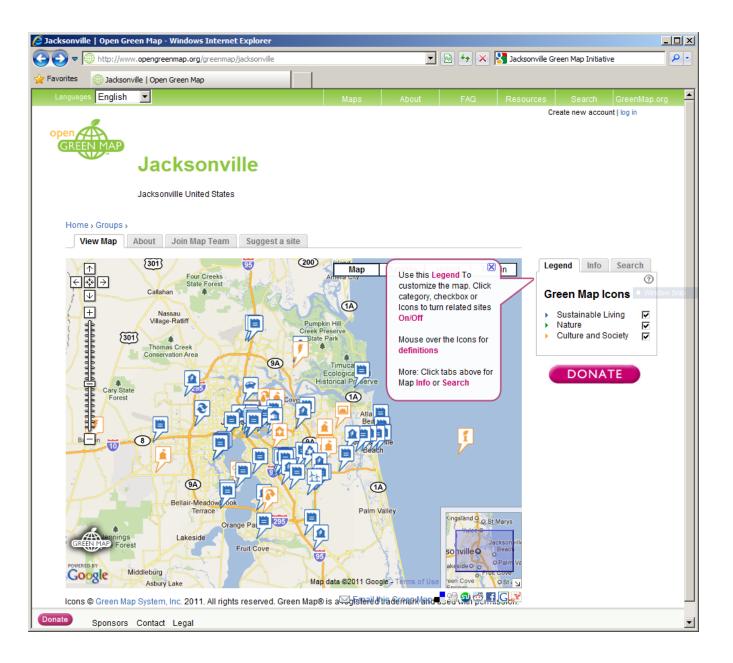
Think Global, Map Local!

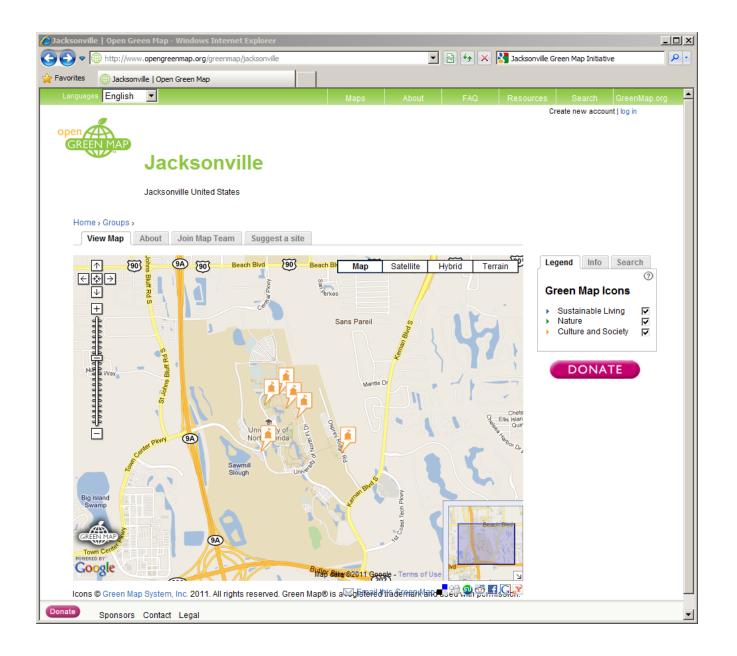
Universal Green Map Icons

Green Map Systems designs & defines the icons, the mapmaker decides the criteria for each designation.

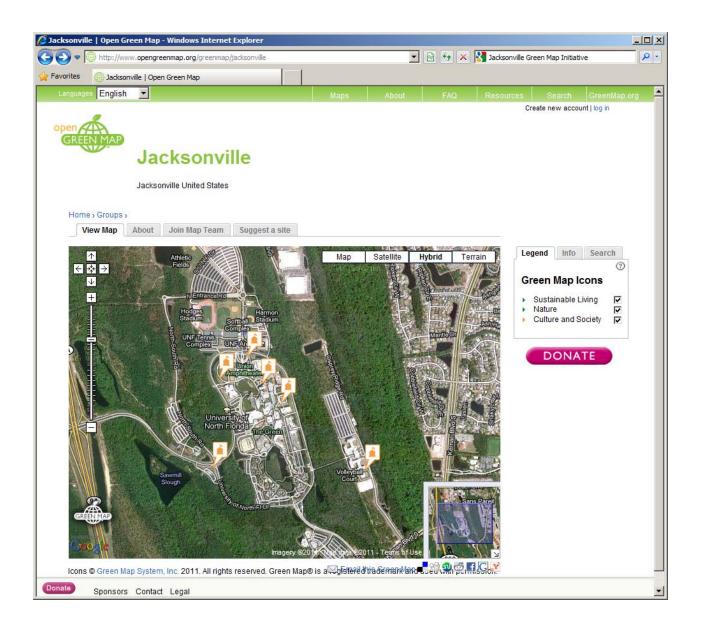




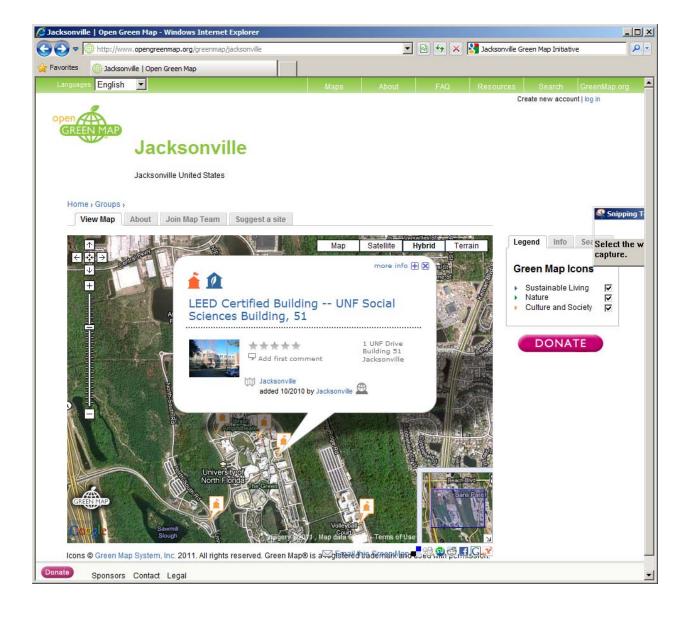

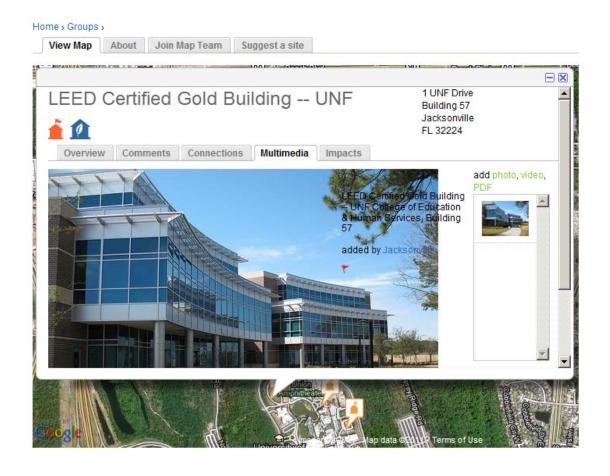

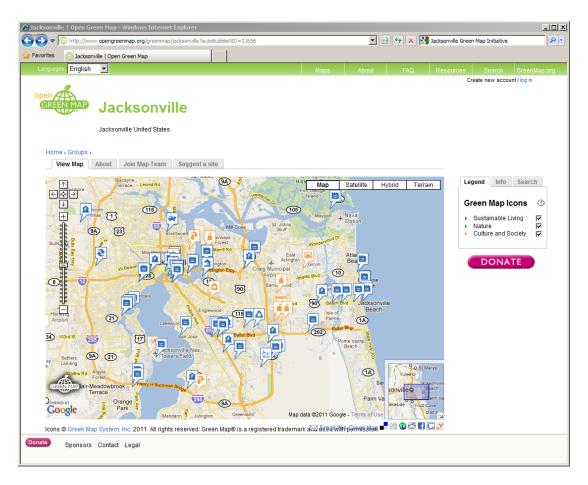
An example: 1st Platinum LEED Certified Home in NE Florida



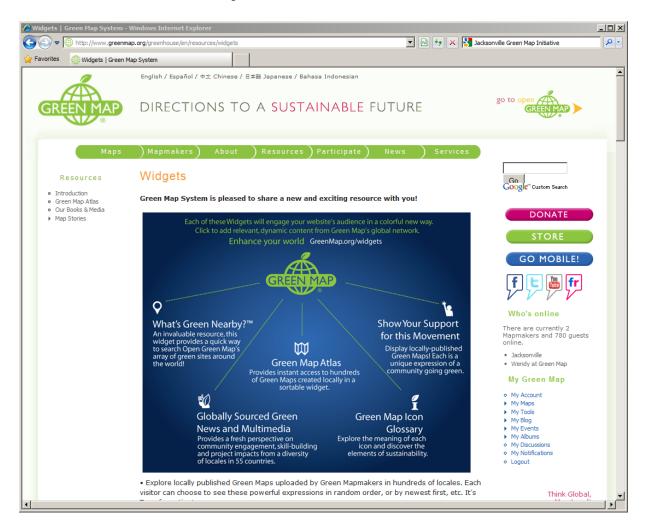

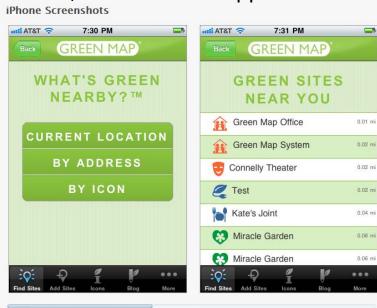


