**NOTICE TO PUBLIC OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC HEARING
for the 2022 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

Notice is given that the City of Jacksonville's ("City") Housing and Community Development Division ("HCDD") has made available a draft of the 2022 Annual Action Plan ("AAP") for a period of 30 days. The AAP provides a summary of the actions, activities, and specific resources that will be used each year to address needs and goals identified by the Consolidated Plan. The City's FY2022 available federal funding amounts are:

Emergency Solutions Grant \$570,440	Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS \$2,720,736
HOME Investment Partnership \$3,604,095	Community Development Block Grant \$6,515,657

Citizens are encouraged to participate in the development of the AAP and review and make comments on the draft plan.
