SUBJECT: Johnson & Johnson Vision Care, Inc.
Annual Reporting for Economic Development Agreements (EDAs) authorized pursuant to Resolutions 2013-521-A & 2015-332-A

Johnson & Johnson Vision Care, Inc. has been authorized to submit a single Annual Survey for the above referenced EDAs. This is due the fact that the EDAs partially overlap with regard to both job creation/retention and terms of the respective REV Grants.

- The First EDA requires the Company to retain 1,872 Permanent Jobs, and create 100 New Jobs, for a total of at least 1,972 Permanent Jobs;
- The Second EDA requires the Company to retain 1,972 Permanent Jobs, and create 100 New Jobs, for a total of at least 2,072 Permanent Jobs;
- Each of the EDAs requires the Company to report annually during the term of the applicable REV Grant regarding compliance with the 1,972 and 2,072 Permanent Job maintenance requirements; and
- The respective REV Grants are based on ad valorem taxes paid on the same real property and tangible personal property.
