Our commitment in 2017 for this project was to maintain 170 new jobs and the 70 existing base jobs created prior to the project in Jacksonville. We exceeded both requirements. We had average wage of \$69,487 which also exceeded our average wage. We continue to grow our presence in the greater Jacksonville and are committed to maintaining our job and wage commitments for this project.
