Subject: **Ordinance 2001-161-E**
Invasive and Nuisance Species

Effective immediately, the following trees will be considered exceptions per 656.1205 for removal of protected trees:

- Pond Willow
- Chinese Tallow
- Paper Mulberry
- Chinaberry
- Camphor
- Wax Myrtle
- Golden Raintree
- Cherry Laurel

As always, tree removal from commercial property requires a permit. A tree of this species may require mitigation if it is meeting a code requirement, was previously planted to meet a code requirement, or previously planted for mitigation. This ordinance only eliminates the requirement for mitigation of the species listed above during new construction or removal of individual trees not meeting any of the listed criteria. In addition, the species listed above may not be used to meet mitigation requirements.
