SUBJECT: Footing/Monolithic Slab Requirements – Single Family Plans

In order to make the plan review and inspection process simpler for single family plans, effective immediately, the Building Inspection Division will accept foundation options being shown on the plans as long as the architect/engineer of record provides specific guidelines as to when the different options he has shown may be used. If no guidelines are provided, whatever is shown on the structural plans must be constructed, or a revised drawing submitted and approved.

Consideration should be given to the difference in allowable bearing, embed development strength for all-thread rods/anchor bolts, maximum height to use a monolithic slab, etc. This list is just some of the things you may want to consider, and is not intended to be all-inclusive.
