SUBJECT: **Landscape Inspection of Irrigation System or Hose Bibs for Commercial Building Permits**

The intent of this Bulletin is to make you aware of changes to procedures for the Landscape Inspection (17) for commercial building permits in order to ensure compliance with the City of Jacksonville's Landscape Ordinance and recently passed Ordinance 2008-030. If your approved building permit included hose bibs to meet your irrigation requirement, and you will be installing an irrigation system instead of the hose bibs shown on your approved plans, you must submit two (2) copies of the irrigation system plans for review as a revision to your building permit (not your 10 set). One approved copy will be returned to you after approval, and should be on site for the landscape inspection. Your Landscape Inspection will not be passed if the irrigation system is not installed per the approved irrigation plan.
