Subject: **Irrigation System Permits**

CLARIFICATION

Any general repair work on irrigation systems, such as replacing heads, solenoid valves or repairing backflow prevention devices, does not require a permit but must be done by a licensed contractor. Any pipe work on existing systems such as adding zones or additional heads would require a permit. Adding an irrigation meter would also require a permit, as would installing a backflow preventor. All irrigation contractors must be licensed by the City of Jacksonville's Construction Trades Qualifying Board before doing any work in Duval County.
