Dear Homeowner:

This letter is to advise you that the intent of the fence requirements around pools is to restrict the entrance into a pool area by unauthorized persons, particularly the protection of small children.

We acknowledge the fact that if a neighbor's fence is already in place immediately adjacent to where your fence should go, adding a second fence on your property, would not be a suitable deterrent, due to the fact that now both fences have horizontal runners where a child can climb one side and down on the other.

Therefore, it is our determination from a practical observation, that an existing fence may be utilized as the required barrier. However, if that fence is removed, you will be responsible to immediately install a new fence. Failure to do so will place you in noncompliance with the City ordinance and subject to the citation process. If you accept this responsibility, please sign below. Otherwise we have no option but to require the additional fence.
