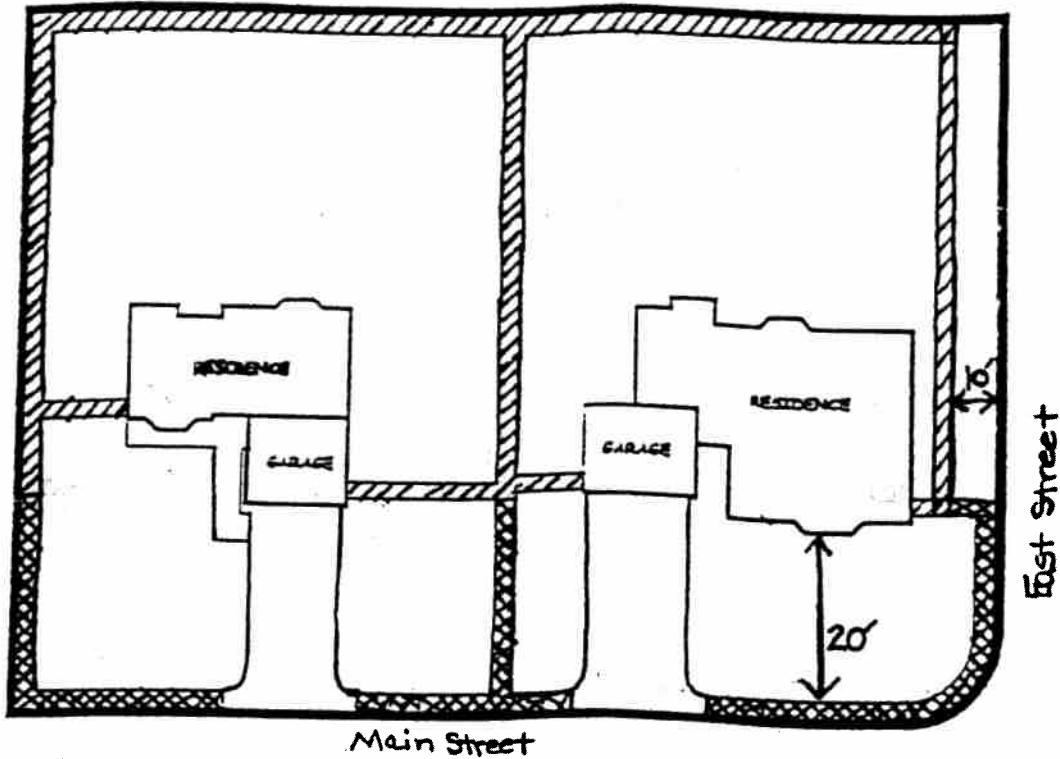


RESIDENTIAL FENCES



City Of Jacksonville, Chapter 656 Municipal Code (656.402)

- Fences and walls are permitted in a required yard up to 8 feet in height; provided however, that no fence in excess of four feet in height shall be permitted in a required front yard in a residential district (yard requirements can be found under the minimum yard requirements section of their respective zoning districts).
- The height of a fence shall be determined by measuring from the ground upward on the owner's side of the fence.
- In the case of a corner lot, a front yard of the required depth shall be provided on one frontage and a front yard half the required depth shall be provided on the other.
- Architectural features may exceed the 4-foot height limitation as illustrated in the figure below.

- ▨ — Wall or fence 4 feet or less
- ▧ — Wall or fence over 4 feet but no more than 8 feet
