NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees that the accounting firm of Goldstein, Schechter, Koch, CPAs of Coral Gables, Florida be retained to advise the Fund on whether the current program of DROP administration is being administered in compliance with the Ordinance Code and to further advise the Board on any procedure necessary to correct any underpayment or overpayment of DROP benefits.
