ACCEPT APPLICATIONS TO PURCHASE OR TRANSFER TIME SERVICE FROM

MEMBERS OF THE POLICE AND FIRE PENSION FUND WHO WISH TO PURCHASE

OR TRANSFER TIME SERVED AS A COMMUNITY SERVICE OFFICER AND FURTHER

TO PROCESS THOSE APPLICATIONS UNDER THE TERMS NORMALLY AFFORDED

TO OTHER CITY EMPLOYEES WHO ARE PURCHASING OR TRANSFERRING

FORMER CITY TIME SERVED.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Jacksonville Police and Fire Pension Board of Trustees:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 37.201 of the Jacksonville Ordinance Code states that public service officers filing temporary positions at the Jacksonville Sheriff's office are not permitted to be a member of the Jacksonville Police and Fire Pension Plan; and

WHEREAS, the General Counsel of the City of Jacksonville issued an opinion dated August 4, 2015 which concluded that Community Service Officers were and are full time employees of the City of Jacksonville (and they are now entitled to be in the General Employees' Pension Plan) and concludes that Community Service Officers have the same rights as any other full-time City

employees who become members of the PFPP but who were not in GEPP, which is that they are entitled to purchase time-service credits for previous full-time employment; and

WHEREAS, because these Community Service Officers may join GEPP, if they become members of PFPF without a break in service, they too, will have the same transfer rights as any other member of GEPP who becomes a member of PFPF without a break in service.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby

RESOLVED, that the Executive Director - Plan Administrator is hereby authorized to accept applications to purchase or transfer time service from members of the Fund who wish to purchase or transfer time served as a Community Service Officer and further to process those applications under the term normally afforded to other City employees who are purchasing or transferring former City time served.
