## **Greenland Park Tree Planting**

### **Scope of Work**

This Level 2 tree planting was developed in collaboration with parks at the request of CM Becton, who has had multiple requests from the residents of the adjacent subdivisions of Greenland Park. The trees planted along the recent field expansion area will serve as a buffer between the recreation area and the neighboring homes. The project will also serve to buffer the walkway and retention pond. There are no removals, and it will consist of 53 trees planted throughout the park. This park offers plenty of area for large shade trees that will serve to provide shade for the recreation and spectator areas as well as increase the tree canopy cover in the City of Jacksonville. A total of 11 trees were selected for this project; a mixture of Oaks, Cedars, Sycamores, and Sabal Palms.
