



Scope of Work

Krestul Park Tree Planting

A group of San Marco area residents have approached the Jacksonville Urban Forestry team and requested a level 2 tree planting project for Krestul Park, to help replace several trees that were previously removed by the parks department. This project requires no removals, and will consist of 34 trees planted throughout the park. A planting project in this area would be great at increasing canopy in an area that has lost several trees over the past several years and choosing Florida native trees will help to provide measurable ecosystem benefits to the natural habitat. A total of 34 trees were selected for this project, based on what would thrive and help the riparian habitat flourish. Locations were selected based on meetings with the group of residents that requested the project, and the Parks Department has approved the plan as presented. All trees will be planted within Krestul Park and are therefore on public property.
