AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND GLAND, THIMS AND MILLER, IN

ENGLAND, THIMS AND MILLER, INC. FOR

CIVIL ENGINEERING AND LAND PLANING SERVICES FOR CECIL COMMERCE CENTER/ALLIANCE FLORIDA (City Contract 6398-22)

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2013, the City and Consultant made and entered into an agreement for Civil Engineering and Land Planning Services for Cecil Commerce Center/Alliance Florida, City Contract # 6398-22 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, said Agreement has not been amended previously; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend said Agreement to increase the maximum indebtedness in Section 3.06 of the Agreement by \$729,535.83 to a new maximum indebtedness amount of \$954,535.83, and incorporate the additional Scope of Services and a cost proposal for such services as set forth in Exhibit "C" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, with all other provisions, terms and conditions remaining unchanged; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement should be amended as provided herein, now therefore

IN CONSIDERATION of said Agreement and for the mutual covenants herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties agree that:

- 1. The above-stated recitals are true and correct and, by this reference, are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.
- 2. Section 3, Subsection 3.01.01 of said Agreement is amended, in part, to read as follows:

- "3.01.01. For the Services, as specified in this Agreement and as described in **Exhibits A** and **C**, an amount not to exceed NINE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE AND 83/100 DOLLARS (\$954,535.83), as detailed in **Exhibits B** and **C**, attached hereto and, by this reference, made a part hereof."
- 4. Section 3, Subsection 3.06 of said Agreement is amended to increase the total maximum indebtedness, and as amended, shall read as follows:
- 3.06. The maximum indebtedness of the CITY for all Services to be performed pursuant to this Agreement shall not exceed the sum of NINE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE AND 83/100 DOLLARS (\$954,535.83).
- 5. Said Agreement is amended, in part, by adding and incorporating therein a Scope of Service and cost proposal as Exhibit "C."
 - 6. Attach Exhibit "C" to said Agreement.

SAVE AND EXCEPT as expressly amended herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement of March 20, 2013 remain in full force and effect.

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
