FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND

PRIORITY TRANSPORTATION GROUP, INC. D/B/A PRIORITY COURIERS For

Ground Delivery Services for the Jacksonville Public Library

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT (the "Amendment"), is
made and entered into this 3 day of 5 , 2014 by and between
CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA, a municipal corporation, for and on behalf of
its Jacksonville Public Library System ("Owner" or "City") and PRIORITY
TRANSPORTATION GROUP, INC. d/b/a PRIORITY COURIERS, a Florida
corporation (hereinafter, "Contractor") for ground delivery services (the "Project").

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2010, the parties made and entered into City of Jacksonville Contract # 9509 (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") for the Project; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement has been amended three (3) times previously; and WHEREAS, said Agreement should be amended by extending the service period from June 4, 2014 to September 30, 2014, with no renewal options remaining, with no increase to the maximum indebtedness and with all other provisions, terms and conditions of said Agreement remaining unchanged; now therefore

IN CONSIDERATION of the Amendment and of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties agree as follows:

1. The above stated recitals are accurate, true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein by this reference.

- 2. Section 6 of said Agreement is amended, in part, by extending the service period from June 4, 2014 to September 30, 2014, with no renewal option remaining and, as amended, shall read as follows:
- "6. The period of service for this Contract shall commence on the Effective Date and shall continue in full force and effect with respect to all its provisions, terms and conditions until September 30, 2014, unless terminated sooner as provided in the Contract Documents."
