**RESOLUTION OF THE MEMBERS**

**WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Ethics Commission is charged by Chapter 602 of the Ordinance Code with making recommendations for legislation deemed necessary to improve the ethics laws of the city; and

**WHEREAS**, in connection with such duties, the members of the Jacksonville Ethics Commission have expressed their approval of Bills 2011-167, 197 and 232 implementing the Charter amendment on Ethics (2010-616) passed by the City Council on November 23, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council unanimously passed Ethics Bills 2011-167, 197 and 232 on June 14, 2011, and

**WHEREAS**, in the interest of promoting public trust in government;

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Jacksonville Ethics Commission as follows:

1. That the Jacksonville Ethics Commission hereby expresses sincere appreciation to the Jacksonville City Council for their support of strong ethics laws evidenced by their unanimous passage of the ethics bills: 2011-167, 197 and 232.

2. The Ethics Commission specifically commends the work of Council Member Glorious Johnson for sponsoring the Charter Amendment on Ethics (2010-616) and Council Member Art Shad for sponsoring the three implementing bills on ethics and for chairing two workshop sub-committees that considered the bills.
