WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Ethics Commission is charged by Chapter 602 of the Ordinance Code with making recommendations for legislation deemed necessary to improve the ethics laws of the city; and

WHEREAS, in connection with such duties, the members of the Jacksonville Ethics Commission have reviewed Bill 2012-212 establishing the Downtown Investment Authority; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is now considering this bill and the Ethics Commission believes in the importance of establishing ethical standards in the implementing language of this legislation, especially in the areas of disclosure of potential conflicts of interest, and

WHEREAS, in the interest of promoting public trust in government;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Jacksonville Ethics Commission as follows:

1. That the Jacksonville Ethics Commission hereby recommends that there be an ethics section added to Bill 2012-212 which requires the Board members and the chief executives of the Downtown Investment Authority to comply with the requirements of state ethics laws on financial disclosure, pursuant to Florida Statute section 112.3145(1)(a)(g).
2. That this resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Jacksonville Ethics Commission on this 7th day of May, 2012.
