This report is submitted in memory of Amari Harley and is a testament to the need to be "Ever Vigilant."

The Council held several meetings with staff members of the City of Jacksonville Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department to review the Department's Park Safety Maintenance Reports for the Subject reporting period.

The results of the inspections by the Parks Facility Safety Officer during the Subject period are presented below (the number of parks in each category on the safety report is listed in parenthesis and the percentage in brackets):

- Number of inspections (175)
- No findings (108), [61.7%]
- Satisfactory with Findings (15), [8.6%]
- Satisfactory with Hazards (35), [20.0%]
- Unsatisfactory with Hazards (17), [9.7%]

A summary of the safety findings & hazards is listed below (the number of parks in each category is listed in parenthesis and the percentage of the parks inspected in brackets):

- Potential injury due to inadequate cushioning in playgrounds (30), (29.7%)
- Potential electrical shock from power sources (3), [3.0%]
- Potential falling hazards from playground equipment and other areas (24), [23.8%]
- Potential impalement hazards from protruding objects (1), [1.0%]
- Potential laceration hazards from sharp or protruding objects (18), [17.8%]
- Potential tripping hazards from loose boards, holes, etc. (24), [23.8%]
- Potential other hazards (9), [8.9%]
- Parks with repeated safety issues (25), [24.8%]
- Corrective action taken over the past 6 months (65), [39.2%]

To: Parks Safety Council RE: Third Quarter Report

As reported from the Third Quarter Report dated 12/5/2022, 175 inspections were completed in that time period. As noted, 108 had No Findings (61.7%). This represents an increase in No Findings by 6.1% over Quarter 2 report (55.6%). An additional 50 (28.6%) were Satisfactory with Findings or Hazards; a decrease of 7.0% from Quarter 2 (35.6%) and only 17 (9.7%) were Unsatisfactory with Hazards; a decrease of 1.5% from Quarter 2(11.2%). Note also that the number of parks with only a single finding was 34 of the 67 parks (50.1%).

These decreases in findings can be attributed to improvements in reporting issues completed as well as increased response times to issues reported. It is the objective to attend to Hazards with immediacy, either the same day as reported or within 24 hours to ensure the item(s) are made safe or taken out of service. It is our goal to continue to increase the % of No Findings and decreasing findings of hazards during inspections.

Of those items listed as remaining open, staff continue to attend to and address finding and hazards through the date of the report on 12/5/2022 and are not listed as such on the report.

The Department appreciates the Councils work and will continue to work to make City parks safe spaces for our citizens and visitors.
