 cannot meet with two members of City Council at one time unless the meeting
 is noticed, and two Parks Safety Council members cannot meet with one
 member of City Council unless it is noticed.
 - Tia Kiett asked if there will be an official time for meetings. Ms. Moore advised that Ms. Godwin-Ware will be reaching out to everyone to coordinate the meeting times and dates.

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- Patricia Kidd asked if the meetings will be hybrid. Ms. Moore advised that the
 meetings can be held hybrid, but the participants attending by Zoom are not
 allowed to vote.
