
Hiking & Bike Trails

Hanna Park offers some of the most scenic and popular trails in Northeast Florida. More than 13 miles of off-road bike trails have something to offer to all skill levels, including the more challenging bike trails characterized by lots of tight turns, short hills and exposed roots. Direction of travel on bike trails changes by day of the week; be sure to follow the posted signs. The park also offers four miles of scenic hiking trails that meander through the maritime forest with majestic live oaks draped in Spanish moss that are enjoyed by both nature lovers and trail runners.

Playscape & Zipline

The playground at Hanna Park is a themed natural playscape centered around a large, custom treehouse. The treehouse is home to hidden squirrels, owls and bears and offers slides, climbing, spinners and a hideout. The playground also features a large spider net, spinning mushroom, fish climber, tree logs, tree stumps and swings. A zipline between the trees with views of the splash pad rounds out the fun at Hanna.
