

A WORD FROM THE CHAIR

My journey with the Jacksonville Planning Council began shortly after witnessing the struggles someone dear to me had endured when seeking HIV care. It was heartbreaking to see and experience the amount of stigma surrounding HIV. Ryan White was a small light in a dark tunnel. The light was hope and as we learned about all the services Ryan White had to offer, the light kept getting brighter. Our experience gave me the desire to be the change I wanted to see. I started



attending Planning Council meetings and that led to other meetings. I realized that individuals affected or infected with HIV can have a voice in their care and the services they receive. This made me feel empowered and confident that we can fight the stigma around HIV if we unite and work together.

Through leadership in planning, developing, and managing human services, the Planning Council strives to assist Ryan White recipients and organizations in meeting human service needs. The Metropolitan Jacksonville Area HIV/AIDS Health Services Planning Council is a group of diverse community members who work to improve the availability, accessibility, and quality of HIV/AIDS health services. As a Planning Council member, you have the great opportunity to participate in processes that identify community needs, the capacity to meet those needs and allocate resources to resolve conflicts.
