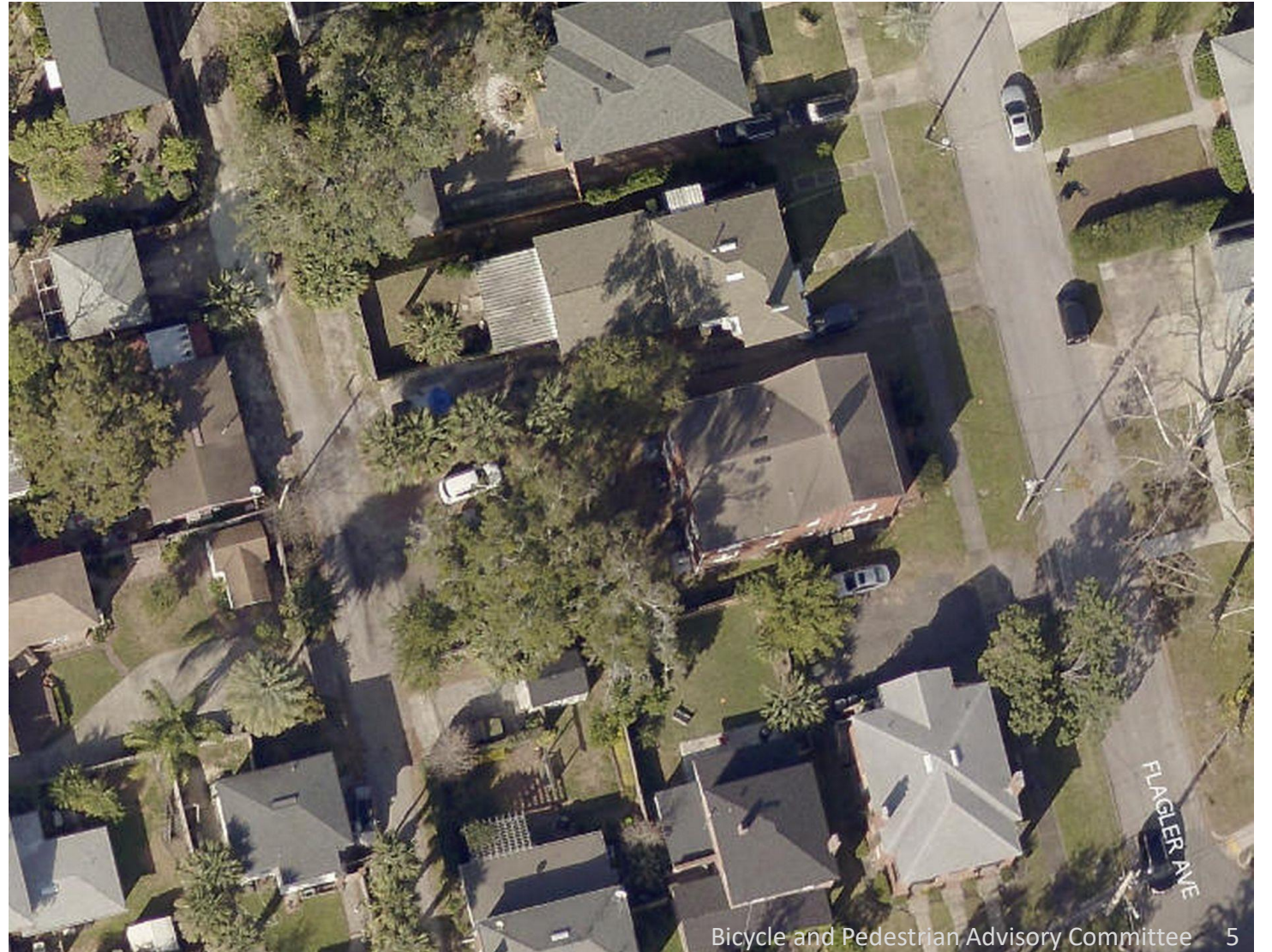

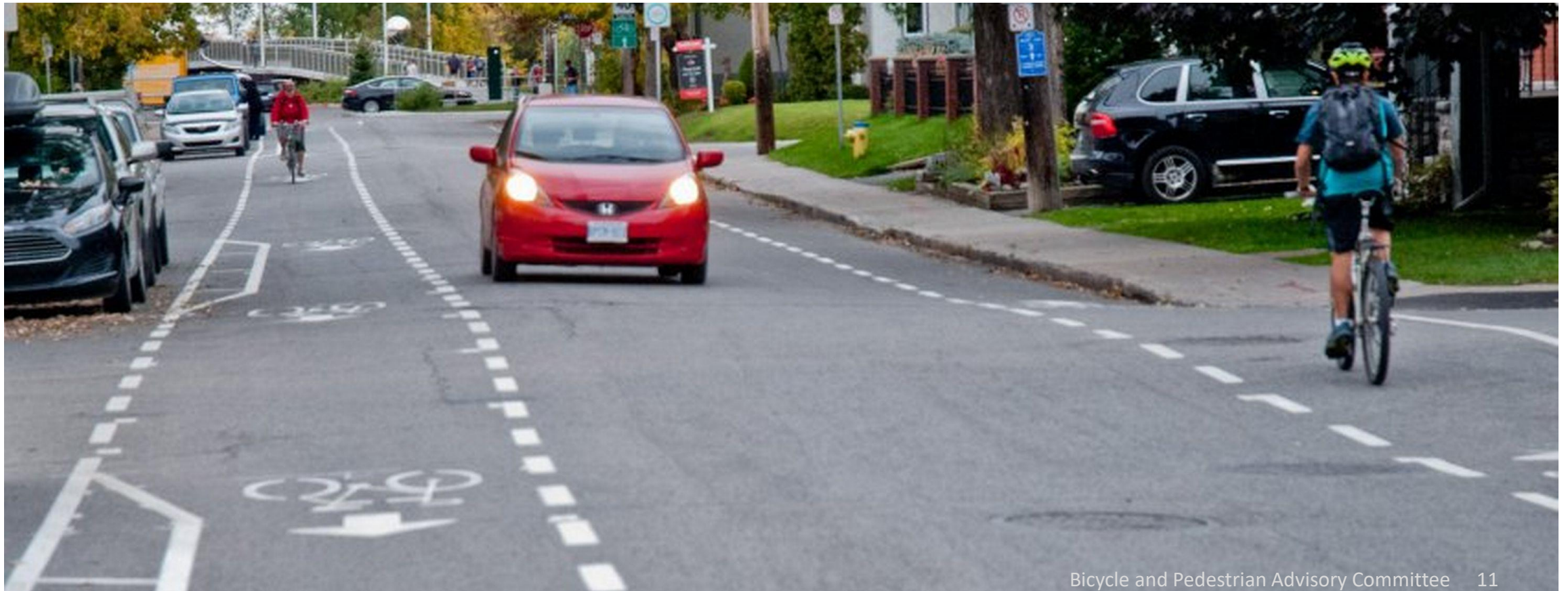


# Ordinance 804.633

8. At the end of the road turn right onto Birch Bark Court North
9. Reach destination

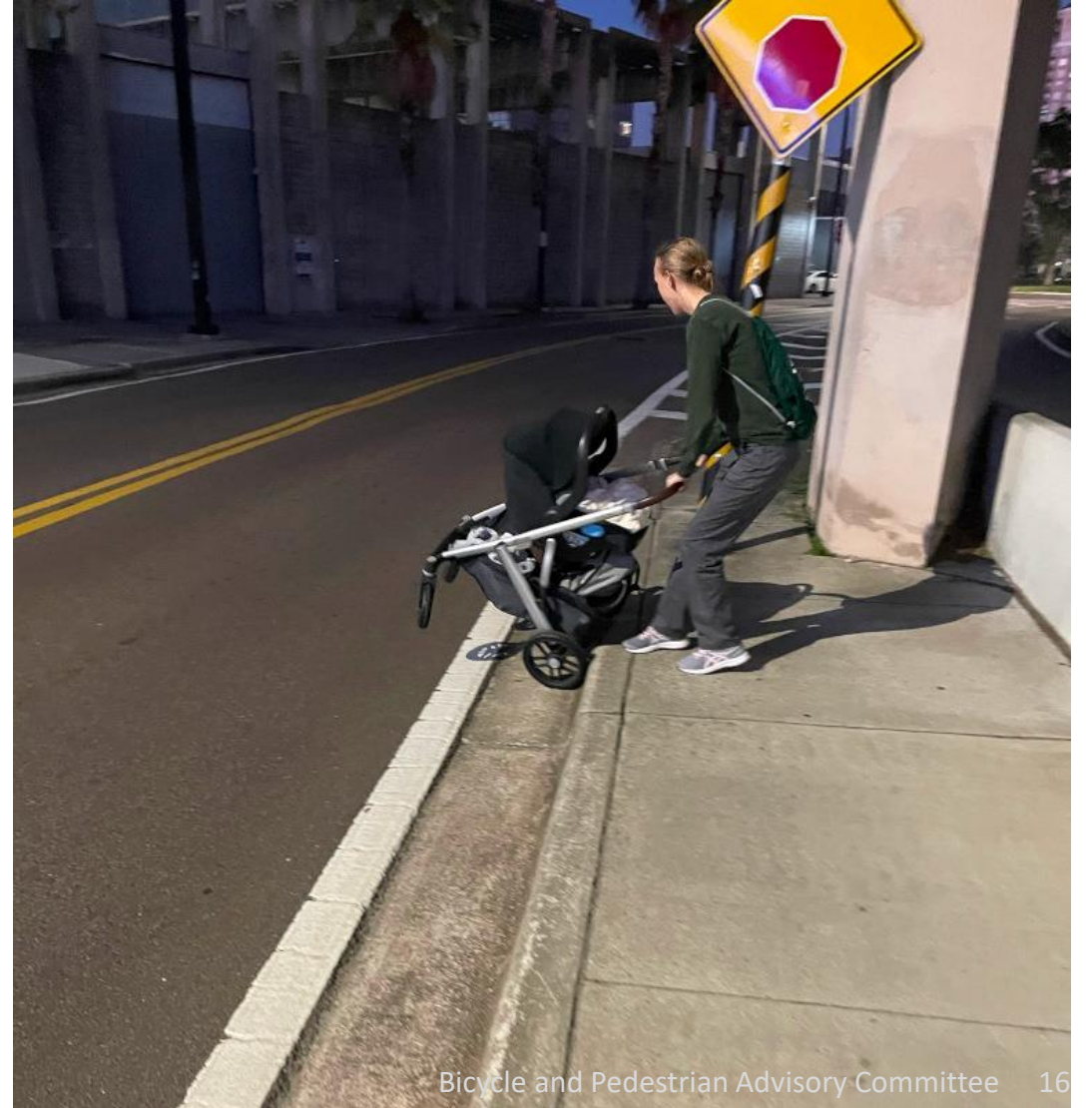

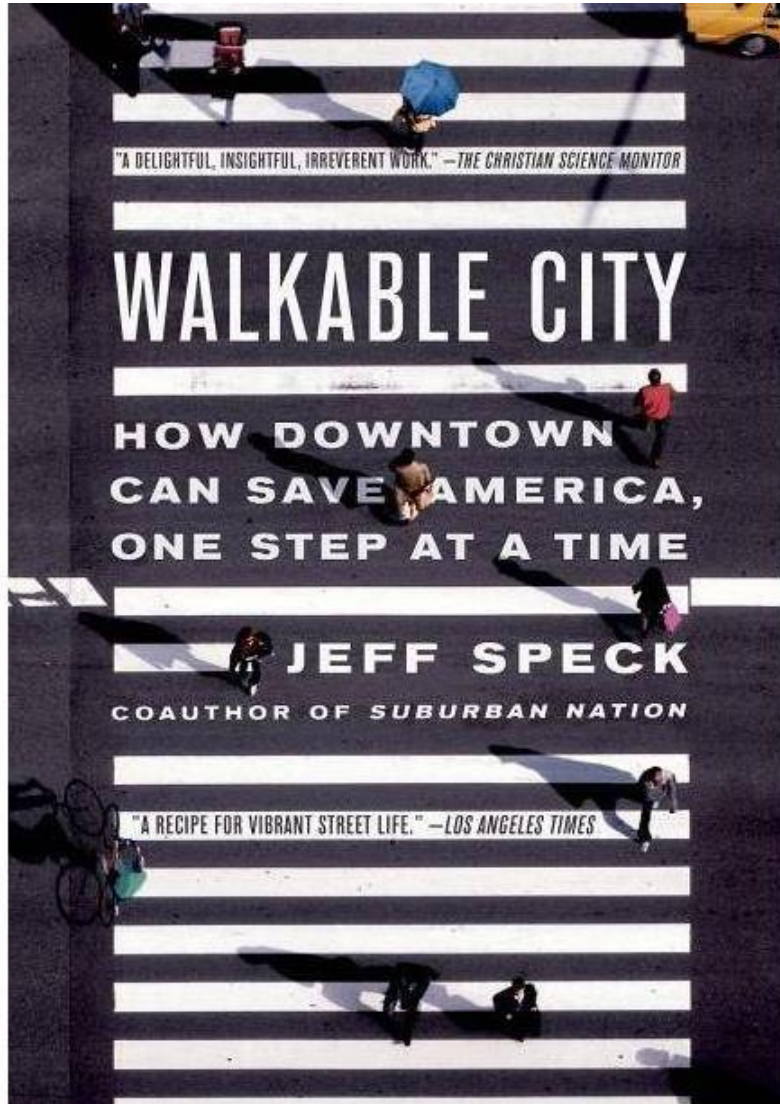

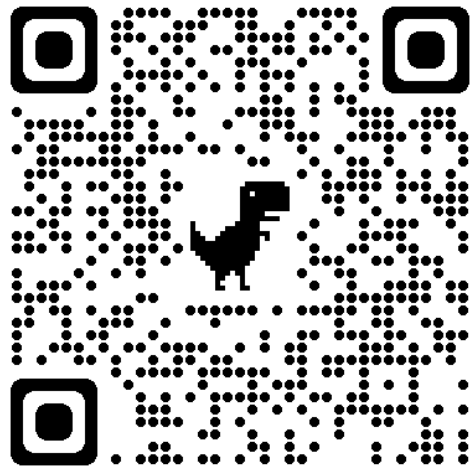
