Welcome to the City of Jacksonville's newly configured website. Find the information you need, fast. Find the department or agency you want, fast. Let's get started.


HOMEPAGE

Access coj.net. The website displays six major sub-sites for you to access: Government, Living, Business, Visitors, Transparency, and Online Services.

Click any of those sub-sites to navigate to a list of links pertaining to those topics.

For example, if you want the e-mail address of your City Council member, click Government on the homepage, then City Council on the sub-site.

If you know what you want to do on the website, then click the **I Want To...** link. On the pop-up window, find your online destination with the drop-down menus (see the image below).



SEARCH

The site allows you to search for a specific item using Google's search engine technology. Type your keywords in the **Search** box and click the magnifying glass icon.




SUB-SITE PAGES

A menu bar appears at the top of each sub-site page. Click on the desired link to navigate to another sub-site page. Click **Home** to navigate to the main homepage.



Each sub-site page contains an extensive list of links to the agencies, departments, and resources that pertain to the topic. In the example below, the Transparency sub-site displays a list of links to relevant city services.



SUB-NAVIGATION TABS

Each department or agency page contains a set of four icons of the far left side of the page:

- < navigation tab,</p>
 - < social media tab,
 - < language translation tab, and
 - < search tab.

The navigation tab displays a pull-out menu with links to various pages related to the department or agency you have accessed. In the example below, the Business sub-site contains links to various city business resources. Additionally, the social media tab displays a list of available resources. The language translation page allows you to change the language of the page. The search tab displays the pop-up search window described on page 1.
