

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Narrative	<p>Live Release Percentage is based on all outcomes for the animals entering the shelter. These outcomes include adoption, return to owner, transfer to another community partner for placement, community cat management, rescue, animals that die in transport or in the shelter, and euthanasia. The goal is to maximize the number of adoptable cats and dogs that leave the shelter alive. In 2003, the live release rate was only 12%, and we have been improving significantly during the past five years since community coalitions were formed with the animal welfare community.</p>
