- WHEREAS: The 2018 tournament, held May 10-13, reached a special milestone, surpassing \$100 million in charitable giving to our community by THE PLAYERS Championship; and
- WHEREAS: A celebration of THE PLAYERS Championship's charitable giving is a celebration of every attendee, sponsor, golfer and volunteer since its inception; and
