

## PROCLAMATION

ONE CITY. ONE JACKSONVILLE

WHEREAS: National Community Development Week is a week-long campaign that emphasizes

both local and national contributions of the Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, which showcases local government projects and services

made possible by CDBG; and

WHEREAS: National Community Development Week provides the opportunity to inform

decision-makers in Washington, as well as constituents, about the significant role CDBG and other federal grant programs play in helping communities and their

residents both survive and thrive; and

WHEREAS: Since 1975, the City of Jacksonville has received over \$398 million in CDBG funds

that have been used to develop and implement a wide range of programs directed toward neighborhood revitalization, economic development, and improving community services, while giving priority to activities and programs that benefit low- and moderate-income people and provide aid to the prevention or elimination

of neighborhood blight; and

WHEREAS: In fiscal year 2019/2020, CDBG funds, in combination with other public and private

funding sources, provided twenty-two multi-family housing units, public facility improvements to senior centers, youth centers, neighborhood facilities, parks & recreational facilities, flood drainage systems, and street & sidewalk improvements;

and

WHEREAS: CDBG funds also provided assistance to 67,318 Jacksonville residents through

public services to include senior services, services for persons with disabilities,

employment services, and other health services; and

**WHEREAS:** In Jacksonville and across the country, CDBG funds have proven to be a tremendous

benefit to the community and citizens who are in need of the services and programs

the funding provides.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LENNY CURRY, by virtue of the authority vested in me as mayor of

Jacksonville, Florida, do hereby proclaim April 5<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021 as
