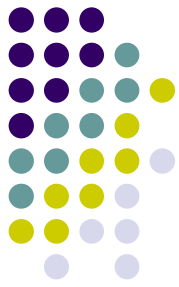




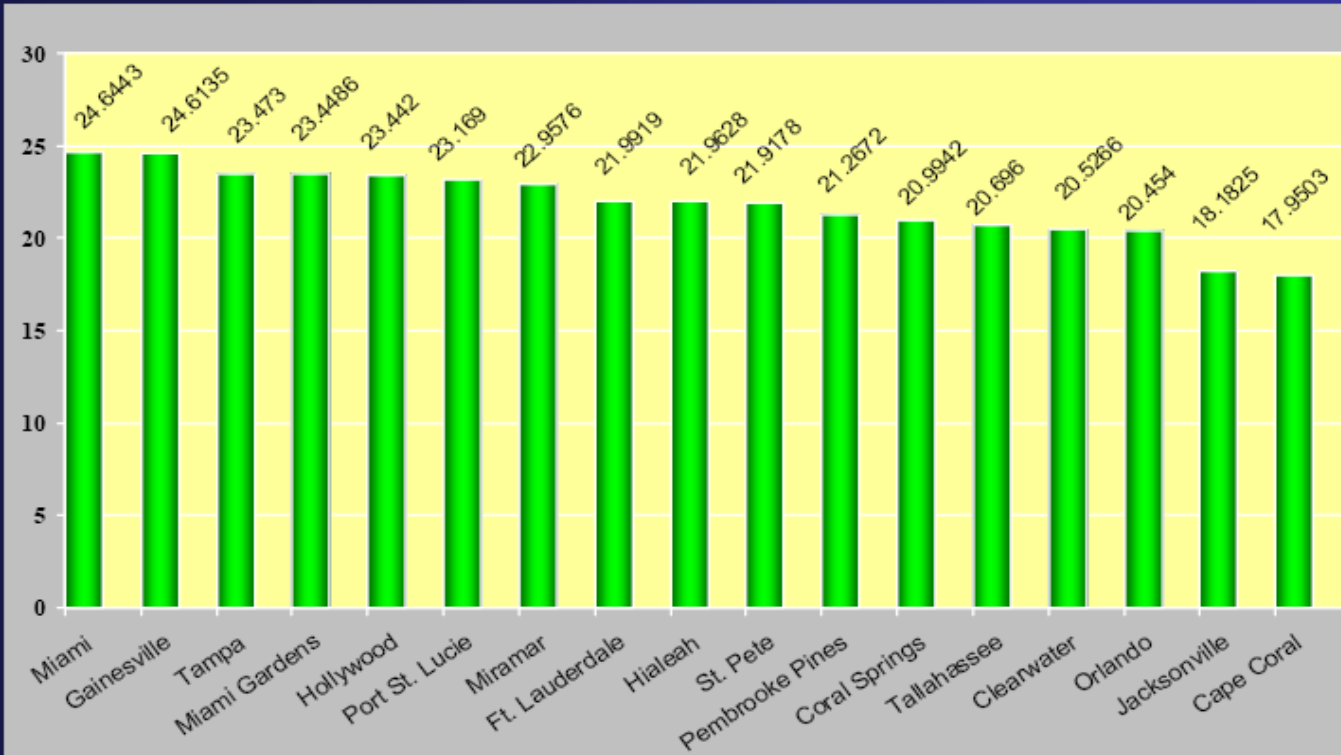

Total ad valorem taxes for 2006 in Florida Cities with over 100,000 population

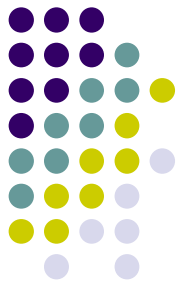
Taxes assessed by government to pay for essential services



2006 ad valorem millage rates obtained from County Property Appraiser's/Tax Collector's Office.

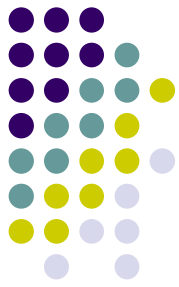

Homicides, 1st & 2nd Half 2006



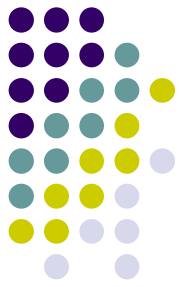

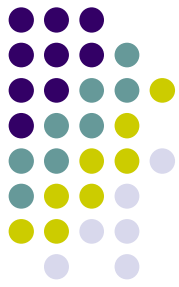

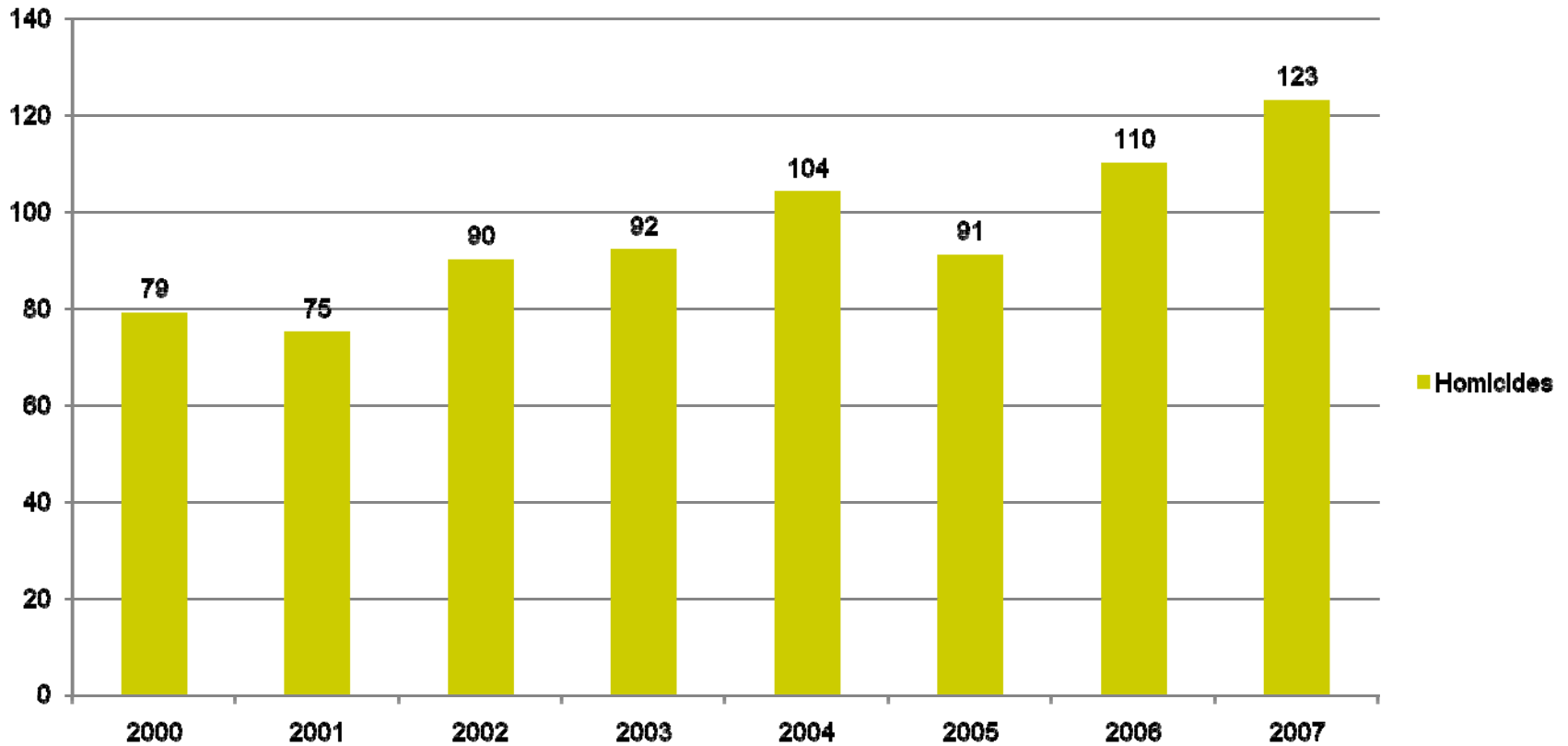

Fluctuation of Homicide, 2000+

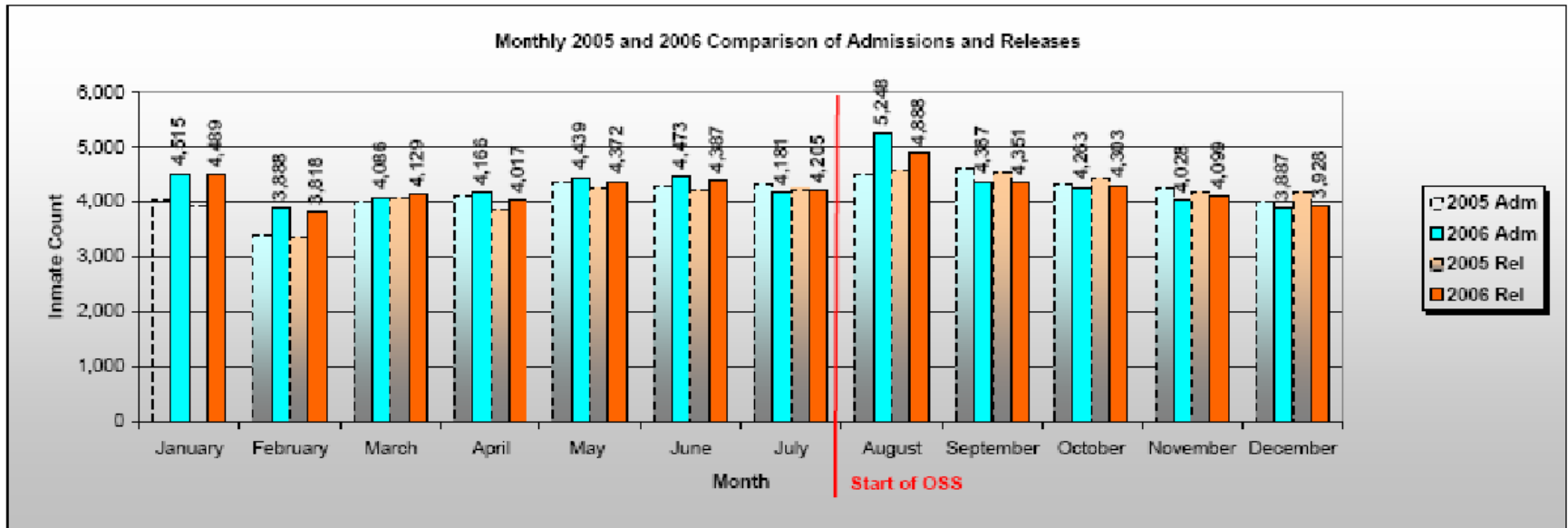
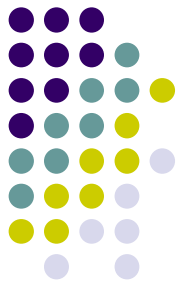

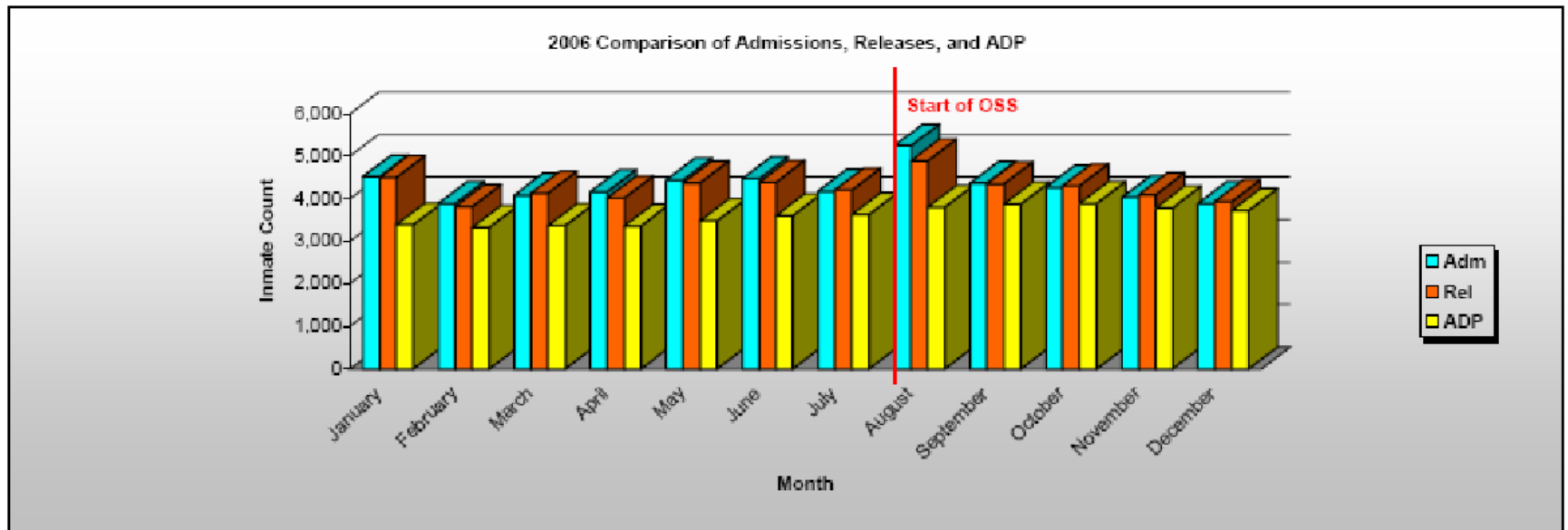

Monthly Count, PTDF, 05-06



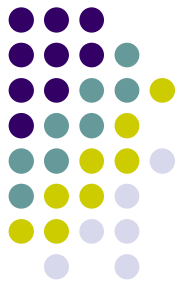

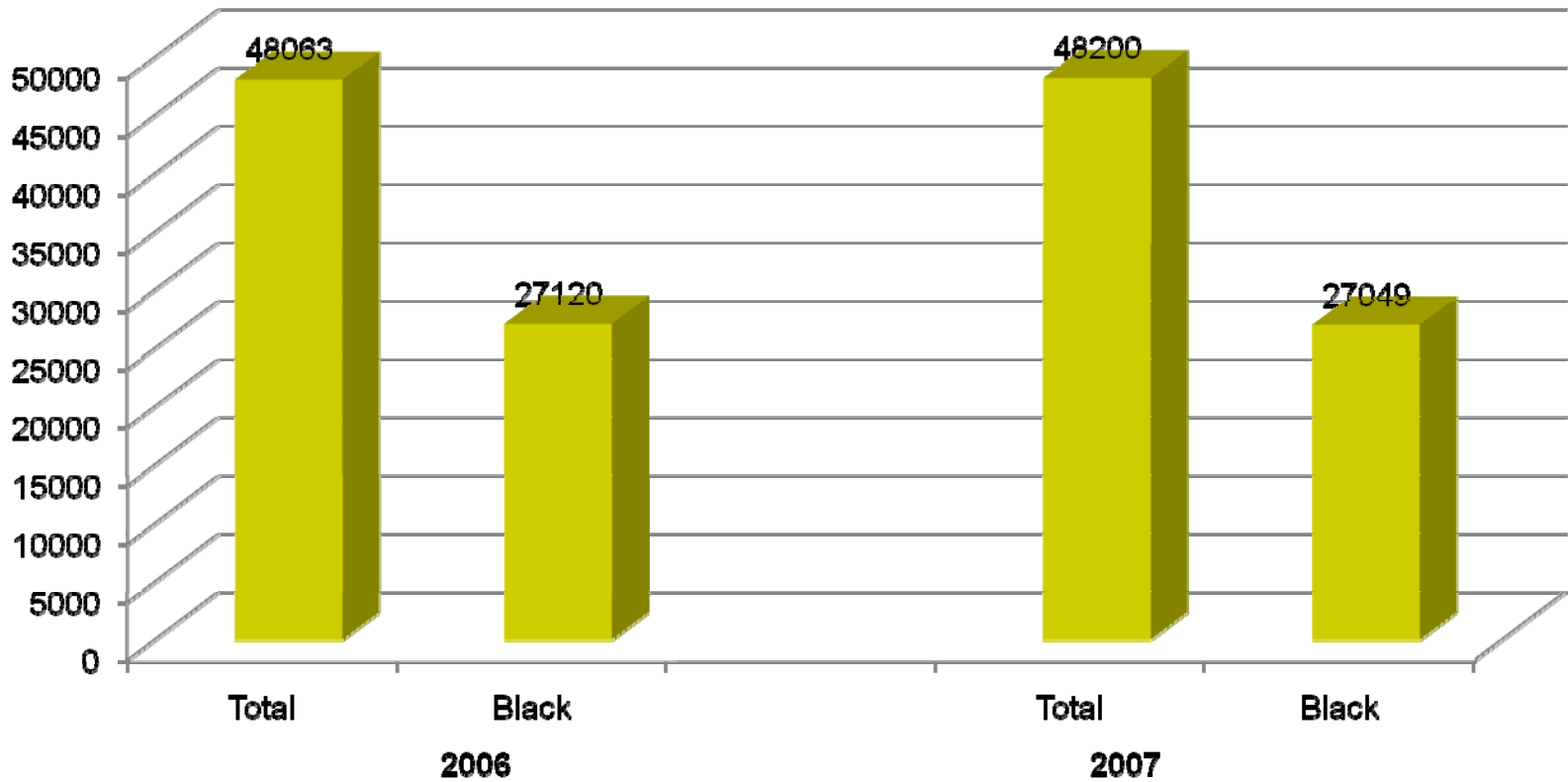

JSO Arrests, 2006 - 2007

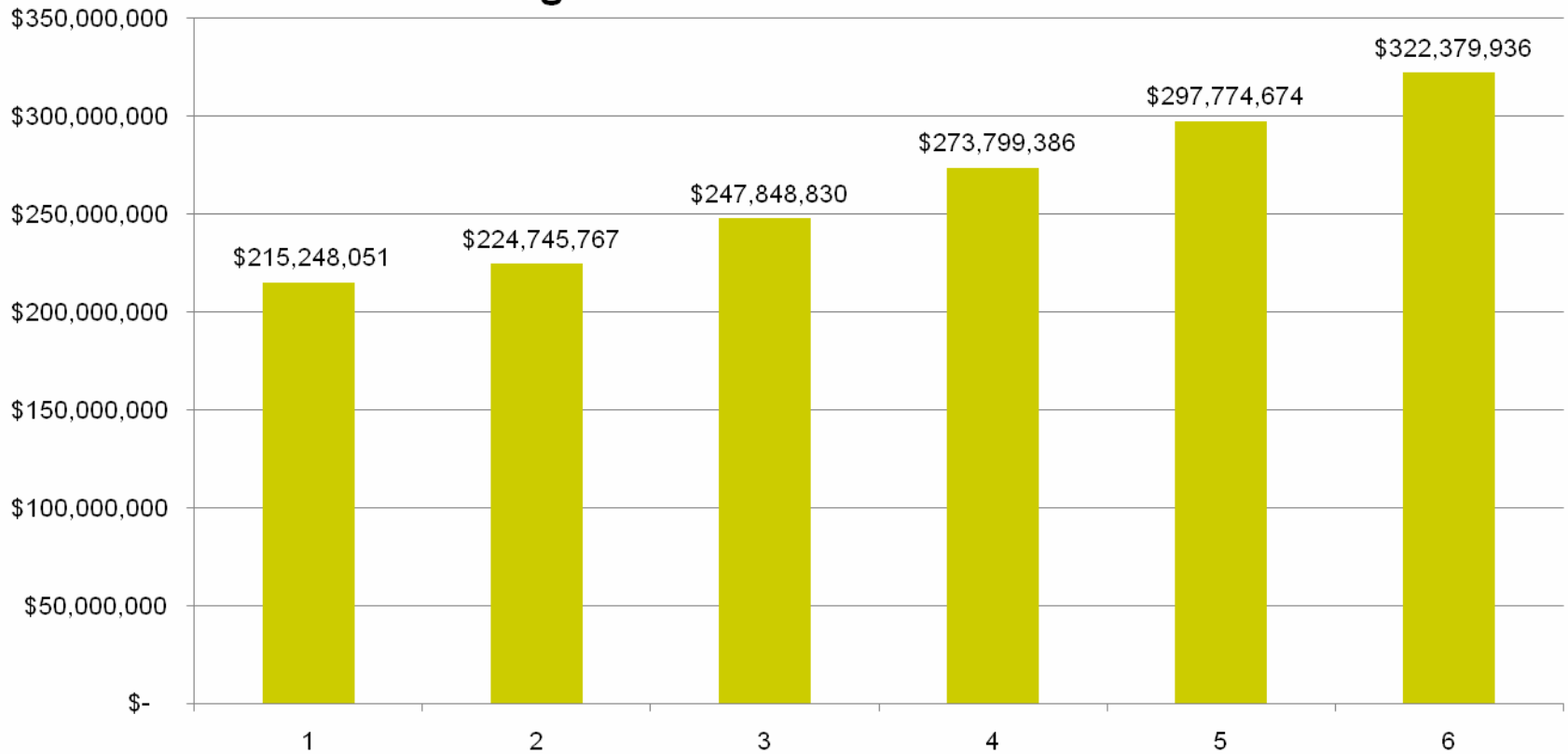

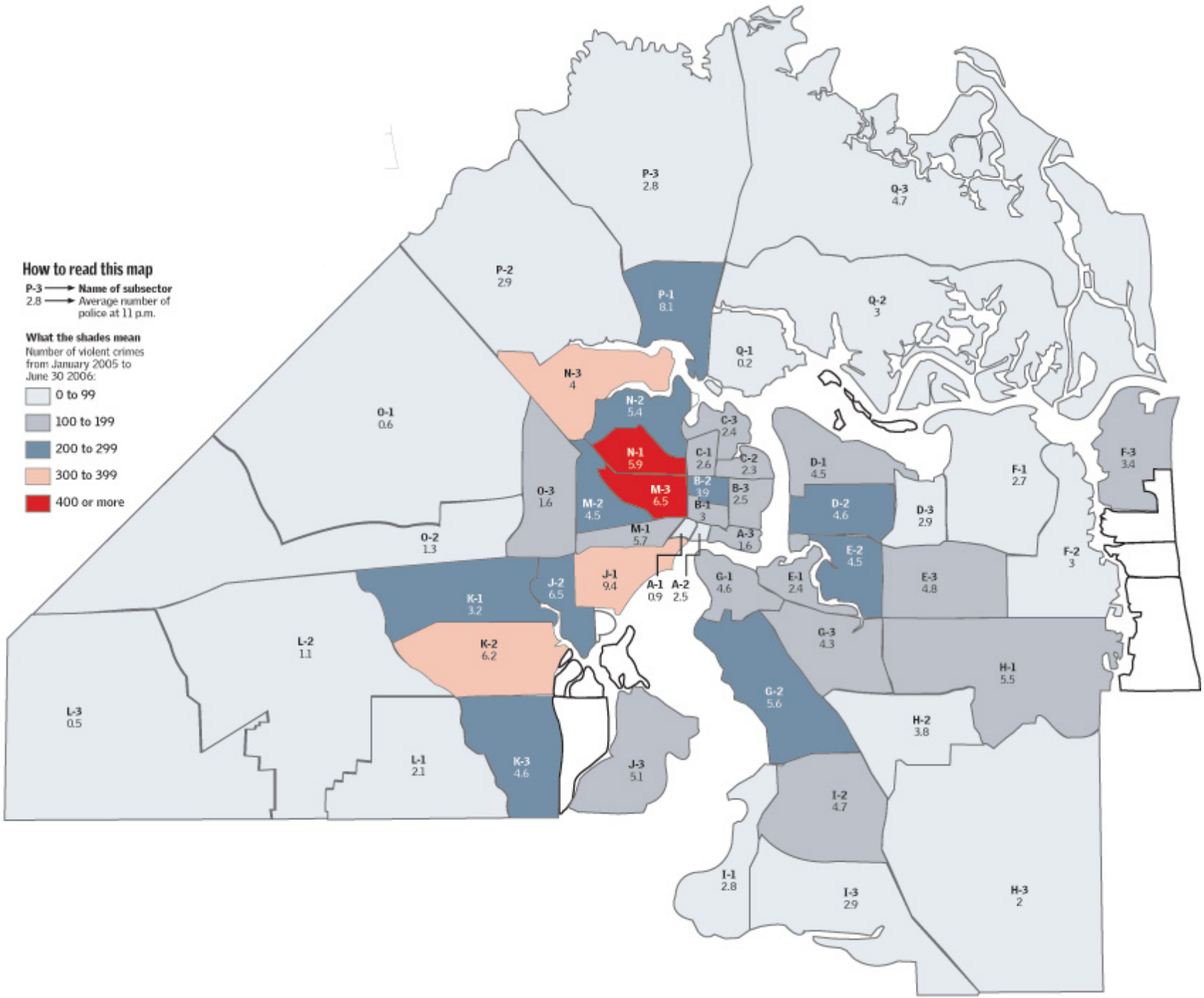

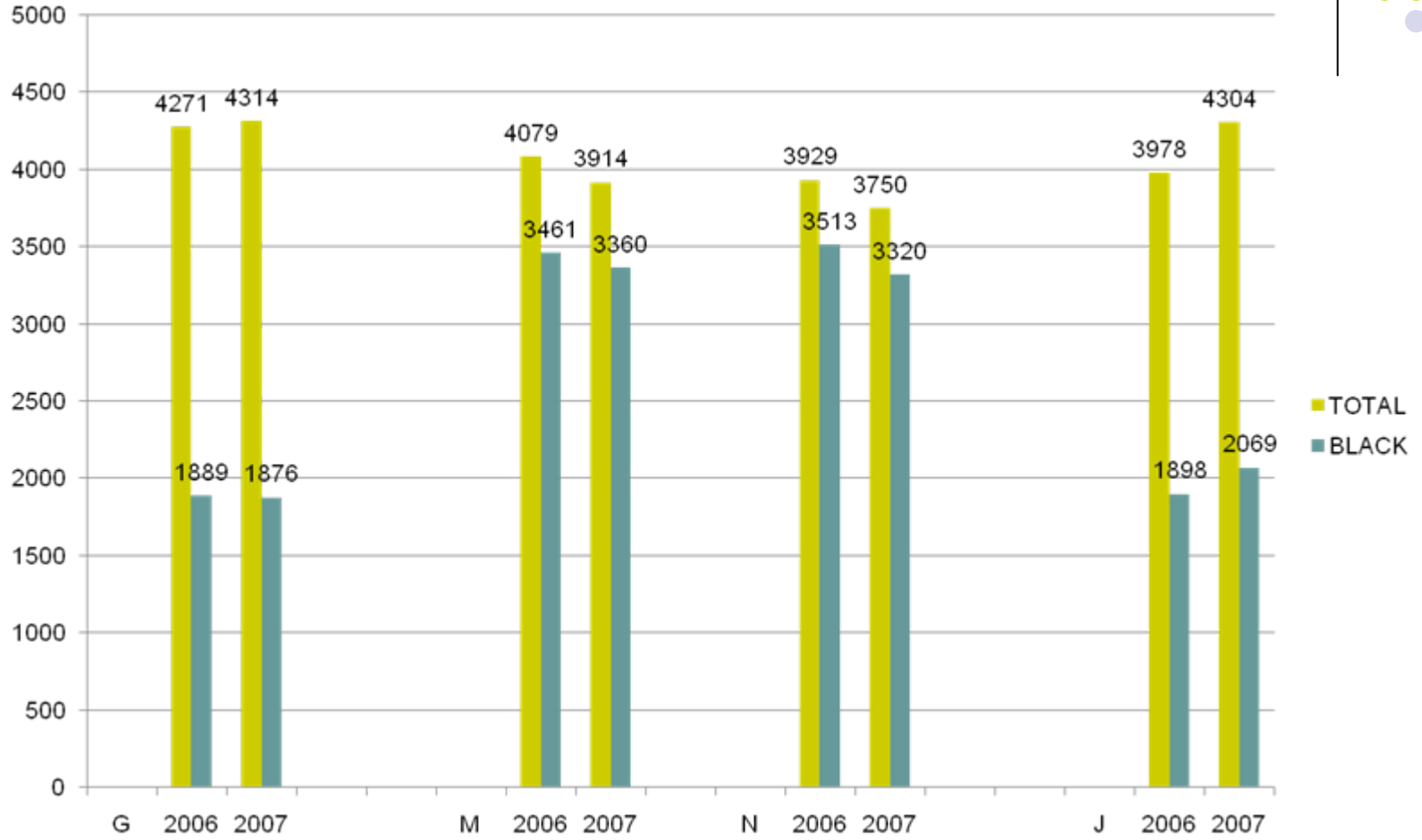
P-3 → Name of subsector

- 400 or more

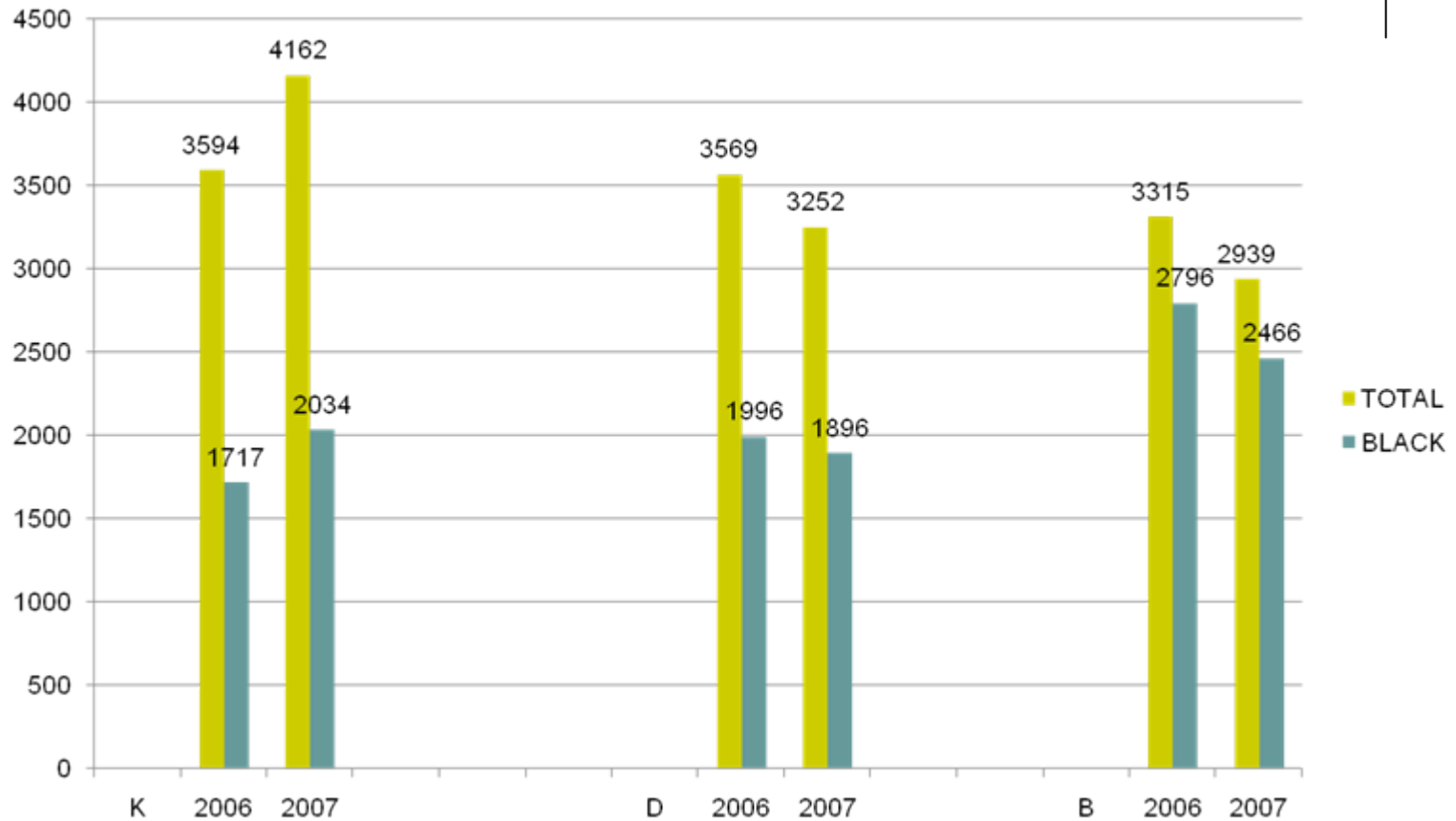


TOP ARRESTS BY ZONE, RACE, 06 - 07

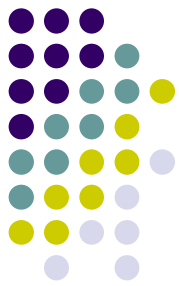




TOP ARRESTS BY ZONE, RACE, 06 - 07



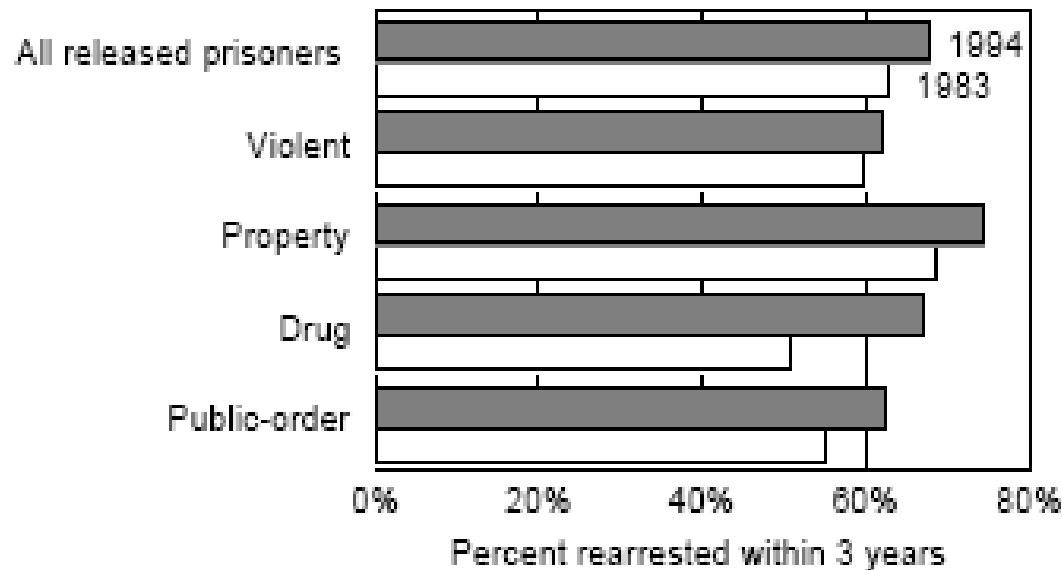
Government Failure



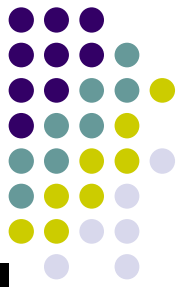
Highlights

Among nearly 300,000 prisoners released in 15 States in 1994, 67.5% were rearrested within 3 years. A study of 1983 releases estimated 62.5%.

Offense of prisoners released in 1983 and 1994



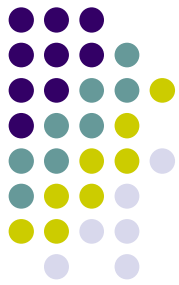
Florida Recidivism



Recidivism Rates in Florida

- **115,000 offenders enter the Florida Corrections System each year.**
- **43,000 of these offenders have never been in the Florida Corrections System**
- **63% recidivism rate for all types of offenses**

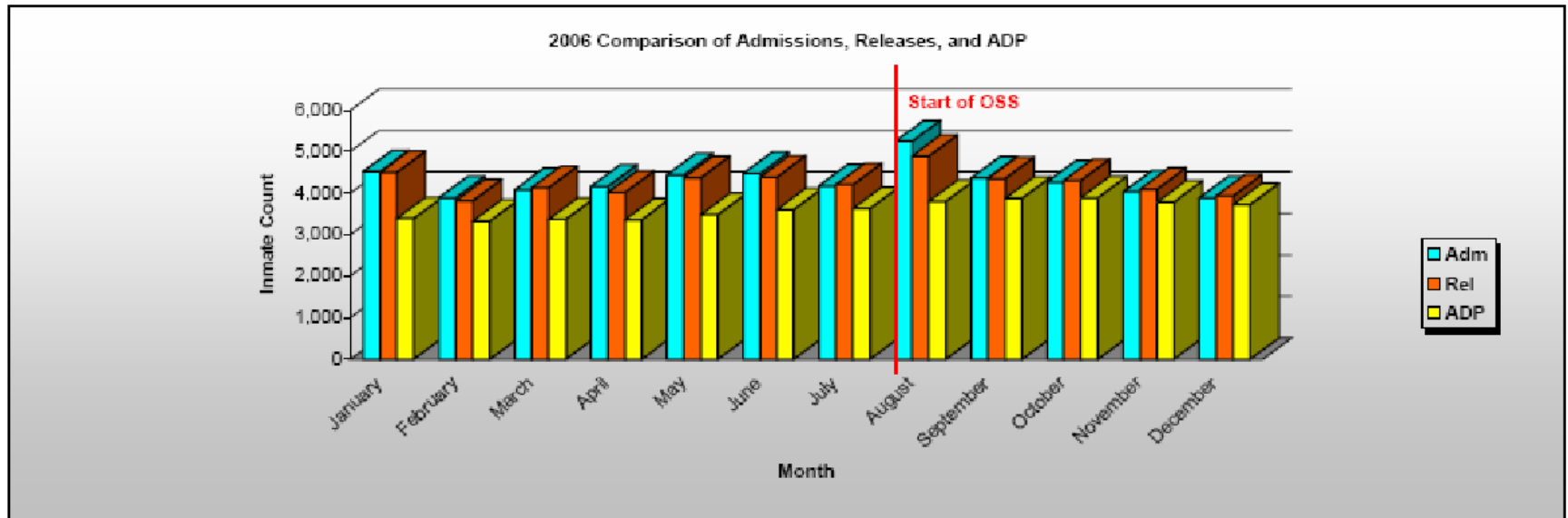
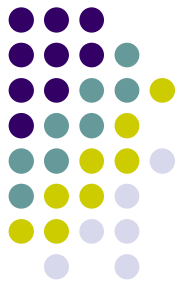

- * 67% Jax homicide victims killed with firearm
- * 93% black on black murder
- * 68% white on white murder
- * 75.77% of murder suspects had prior arrests
- * 53.05% of victims had prior arrests
